

NATURE HOLIDAY LEPÄNJUURI

Nature Holiday Lepänjuuri, a small rural enterprise in the Central Finland, is focused on developing the bio-diversity of nature and the traditional landscape. The farm, around which the area has been built, follows an ecological forest management plan. Forests are carefully managed and an arboretum is grown on the fringes of the fields. Sheep and a scythe aid in transforming the fields into flowering meadows. Naturally, forest animals are protected – there are feeding points for animals and nest boxes for birds. These surroundings provide you with a great possibility to enjoy the peace of nature, to make an excursion, to attend a course, to camp or simply spend your vacation.

Nature Path

You can enjoy the rich natural environment by walking the three-kilometer-long Nature Path and by stopping every now and then to answer the 28 questions about nature that are located by the path. There is also a lookout spot called Unelmakallio (the Rock of Dreams) and a bird watching tower. Guide services are available on request.

Forest Observation Path

The Forest Observation Path is 700 meters long and it runs through the forest managed by an ecological management plan. Alongside the path you can see different experimental forest management areas as well as 20 forest and landscape observation spots.

Nature Camps

You and your group can camp out or have a meeting at Nuotioniemi (the Campfire Cape), which is located by a sandy and rocky beach. A hut, a sauna, two lean-to shelters, a spring well, a cellar, campfire sites and a rowing boat are at your disposal.

Nature Courses

You can learn new things about nature and its plentiful gifts. We organize nature protection events as well as mushroom, herb and meadow courses, where you have a possibility to learn more about different kinds of mushrooms and plants.

Cottages

We rent summer cottages on the shore of Lake Keitele and on the mainland as well.
